<sup>1</sup> This column lists the entities communicating with the Special Master in response to Judge Korman's invitation to companies seeking releases as Slave Labor Class II users of slave labor to "identify themselves to the Special Master..." A number of communications came from attorneys; they are not identified on this Table.

<sup>2</sup> A number of companies communicating with the Special Master provided lists of subsidiaries acquired after World War II. Because Slave Labor Class II employers must have been Swiss-Owned during the War era, they are not listed on this Table. Similarly, some companies listed subsidiaries owned during World War II doing business in locations where no slave labor use is possible. At least one entity, for instance, identified its subsidiary in Shanghai. These are also not listed on this Table.

<sup>3</sup> A number of companies communicating with the Special Master denied knowledge of past slave labor use. Others reported that they knew of no such slave labor use, but could not unequivocally rule it out. Companies appearing on this Table, therefore, are not necessarily employers of members of Slave Labor Class II.
