Dear Sirs,

after having received the notice of Special Master's Interim Report we decided to send you our proposal for taking part into the challenge of using the sum as the surplus after dividing the amount from the Swiss Banks.

1. We are a small Jewish Community in the Czech Republic and the history of the Jewish population in Olomouc goes back to the 11th Century. Before the WW II. The Jewish Community in Olomouc had more than 3550 members and a wonderful synagogue unveiled in 1897 in the very center of the town of Olomouc.
2. During the Holocaust more than 3200 Jewish citizens were killed and in 1945 approx. 300 Jewish people returned from the Concentration Camps and from abroad. Our synagogue was burnt down in 1939, the first day of the Nazi's occupation. In 1948, when the Communist regime was installed, 50% of the Jews left Czechoslovakia again and settled down in Israel, USA, England, Sweden and in other lands. During the Communism the number of our Jewish members went down to some 43 in 1989. After the Velvet Revolution we reached our membership at 180 and today we are responsible for the Jews living in 5 districts around Olomouc.
3. Our members, of who 52 are the Holocaust survivors, are between 60-90 years old and nearly all of them are either ill or physically or mentally handicapped. We are trying to help them in their mostly tragic situation but our financial means are limited.
4. Therefore we dare to present you our proposal as follows:
 5. The Jewish Community in Olomouc is planning to enlarge its Social and Health Center for the Holocaust survivors in helping them to enrich their old age. This help will be executed by the following activities:
 - 5.1 Ensuring the home care for the Jewish members in need.

- 5.2 Paying them medicaments, health advices and medical care which are not covered by the healthy insurance and state care.
- 5.3 Visiting the Holocaust survivors as frequently as possible encouraging them and helping to overcome their oppressive situations.
- 5.4 Helping them to enrich their lives by supplying them furnishings for the household, which they are not able to buy.
- 5.5 To arrange their transport to the Jewish prayer house on the High Holidays and Shabbat services.

6. The budget for the above mentioned activity:


- 6.1 The length of this activity: 3 years from 1 January till 31 December 2006.
- 6.2 The number of the helped members:
 - 2004: 50
 - 2005 48
 - 2006 45
- 6.3 The proposed financial help for one person:
50 USD monthly.
- 6.4 Total cost:
 - 2004: $50 \times 12 \times 50 = 30\ 000$ USD
 - 2005: $48 \times 12 \times 50 = 28\ 800$ USD
 - 2006: $45 \times 12 \times 50 = 27\ 000$ USD


