Dear Chief Judge and Special Master,


I am writing you in my capacity as Member of the Israeli Knesset, to voice my support for the funds allocation proposal of the Pink Triangle Coalition. As a member of the Israeli Knesset, it is my conviction that gays and lesbians have not been adequately compensated for the suffering and loss they endured during the Nazi Holocaust.

The distribution proposal of the Pink Triangle Coalition is important because gay survivors of the Holocaust have not been easily identifiable through the usual channels. The Coalition's for a *cy pres* distribution will ensure:

1. Financial support for gay survivors;
2. Monies for scholarly research into the brutalization of gays and lesbians at the hand of Nazis;
3. Funding for education programs in both schools and museums; and
4. Support for human rights efforts to safeguard the liberties of gays living under oppressive regimes in the Middle East and elsewhere.

I am familiar with the Israeli member of the Pink Triangle Coalition, the Aguda, which has acted as a respected advocacy and support group for the Israeli gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender community for over 25 years. The Aguda actively works with gay survivors of the Holocaust, and I am confident that any funds, which may be distributed to the Coalition, will be appropriately used to help preserve the memory of these 'forgotten' victims.

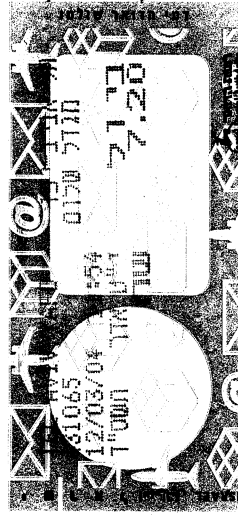

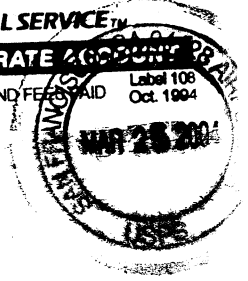

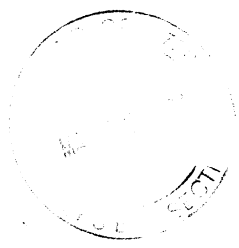
